SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

[A]nd on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. (Gospel for Jan. 5, Mt 2:11a)

The solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord recalls the visit of the Magi to the infant Jesus. The Magi recognize the newborn king and offer him homage. This great feast occurs during the liturgical season of Christmas, which begins on Christmas Eve and continues through the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. 

Deacon's Mark's Homily Part 3

For the last 2 months we talked about Deacon Mark's Sept 28th 4 PM homily and he hit on 3 major points:

- 1) The condition we're in currently.
- 2) How we got here.
- 3) What are we going to do about it. (This month's reflection).

I think the obvious place to start is with ourselves. The last words of the Book of Judges ring true: "In those days there was no king in Israel; all the people did what was right in their own eyes."

In his comments on that last line, Bishop Barron writes: "I would not interpret this necessarily as an endorsement of kings in the political sense, but rather leadership in the moral sense. A healthy society needs leaders – political, economic, cultural, religious, etc. – who are animated by a keen sense of objective moral value".

I would argue that without God in a society, there can be no moral value. I would also argue, as Deacon Mark does, that the moral leadership has to come from God and by extension, the Church and the teachings of the Church that have not changed over the last 2000 years. While there have always been voices wanting the Church to change to fit into the world around us, the teachings of the Church actually do just the opposite, the teachings of the Church instead, seek to change the world. The Church's teachings are not dynamic and changing with the moral social interpretation of any given time.

The teachings of the church are static and consistent, that form for us a moral standard that we should use to judge everything around us, political, economic, and cultural. Once we have that, the next step is to share that with others, to follow the teachings of the Church and to evangelize God and the Church to the world.


I have a coffee cup with a quote from St. Francis of Assisi that says "Preach the Gospel at all times – if necessary, use words".

Let the power of that simple quote sink in for a minute. It speaks volumes about our everyday actions.











Robert Fulghum once wrote:

"Without realizing it, we fill important places in each other's lives. It's that way with the guy at the corner grocery, the mechanic at the local garage, the family doctor, teachers, neighbors, coworkers. Good people who are always "there," who can be relied upon in small, important ways. People who teach us, bless us, encourage us, support us, uplift us in the dailiness of life".

I suggest that there are those who depend on us for the same things, who watch us, learn from us, take from us, who's lives may have been changed for the better by something they heard us say, or watched us do. The rub is, we very seldom know what we said or did, and will probably never who they are.


And so, Jesus's commandment: "Love thy neighbor".

To that point, it's important to understand we are not alone in this. Taking with us the teachings of the Church, we share this responsibility to evangelize the Word of God to our families and to the world with others who share our common belief in God and Jesus, whatever denomination they may be, and with our Jewish brothers and sisters, the only faith that has been demonized longer than ours.

In short, we need to quit fighting among ourselves as Christians and Jews and start to seek what we have in common, and to build on that to push back against Satan and his minions.

It's a hard road to follow, but with so many now lost in the darkness of socialism, it is a road we must travel.



Korean & Vietnam War Census Program

The Fourth Degree will conduct a census of the membership to establish a record of service in the Korean and Vietnam Wars.

Following the World Wars, the Order documented war service by its members in the archives at the Blessed Michael J. McGivney Pilgrimage Center however similar efforts were not conducted following either the Korean or Vietnam Wars.

The Korean War commenced in 1950, making the approximate minimum age of surviving veterans ninety-one years old. The approximate minimum age of surviving Vietnam veterans serving from 1965-1973 is 68-76 years old. Both the Korean and Vietnam Wars marked a significant departure in how troops served and returned from war, as service was no longer for the duration. Gone were the hero's welcome on return. Vietnam veterans returned to a hostile and divided nation, where they were either overlooked or criticized for their service.


For Assemblies working in conjunction with their assigned councils in conducting the census of their membership please use the most current form;

Where possible, documented service of deceased members needs to be recorded. Inclusion in the census shall be limited to veterans meeting the requirements established by Congress for the Korean Service Medal you must have served from June 25, 1950, to July 27, 1953, and was on permanent assignment or on temporary duty for 30 consecutive days or 60 non-consecutive days and performed his duty within the country of Korea. For the Vietnam Service Medals, you must of served from July 3 1965 to March 28 1973 and was on temporary duty for at least 30 consecutive days or 60 non-consecutive days or have served in combat with a unit directly supporting a military operation in Southeast Asia (Vietnam and the contiguous waters and airspace in Thailand, Laos, or Cambodia; or the airspace thereof and in the direct support of military operations in Vietnam.

Certificates recognizing service will be delivered to surviving veterans via their councils. District Masters, it is recommended that you reach out to all your Faithful Navigators to collaborate with their local Grand Knights to hold a party or dinner for those Veterans receiving the certificate. There should also be a 4th Degree Honor Guard present during the certificate presentation. Let us show our appreciation to those veterans in our council who served in these two wars and to let them know that their sacrifices are not forgotten.

Uniform

Regalia Wear – the KofC Fourth Degree standard is "One Button" used on the jacket. See the Drill Manual for photographic examples. The Bottom Button of the jacket is not used.

Could you wear the Fourth Degree uniform blazer with other slacks and a regular tie when going out? The answer is: No

Our uniform was designed to be worn complete with the Fourth Degree blazer, official slacks, tie, and official Fourth Degree pin (PG-113). It also requires a white dress shirt with no button-down collar, black shoes, and black socks. However, it may be worn in social settings such as Knights of Columbus events, banquets, exemplifications, meetings, and church.

The other components of the uniform are used when participating in our color corps (color guard or honor guard). Those include the official beret with flash representing office (if any), white gloves, a service baldric, a Fourth Degree sword with scabbard. Flag bearers would not wear baldric or sword. (Note that the service baldric is either a general member baldric or else a specific color to indicate your current office held).

So, if you want to show your pride as a member of the Fourth Degree, then wear all the components according to the laws and rules of the Fourth Degree.




