The Cause for Canonization of Blessed Father Michael J. McGivney is at a favorable stage at the Vatican and you can help him on his way to sainthood. Since he was declared a Venerable Servant of God in March 2008, and a miracle through his intercession has opened the way to beatification, we are near the final phase of the process. One more miracle is needed for him to be eligible for sainthood.

The long and complex process is explained in more detail [here](#). But your part is simple and direct, and can be summed up in three words: **PRAY. REPORT. JOIN.**

PRAY. Your prayers can take two forms: to and for. Pray *to* Father McGivney that he may intercede for you and others in times of need, especially in cases of serious illness.

Pray *for* Father McGivney's cause, that it may continue to move forward with favorable reports.

You may join members of the Guild throughout the world in reciting the [official Prayer for Canonization](#), or you can pray in your own words.



Knights of Columbus councils and families especially should engage in these prayers, but anyone who is devoted to Father McGivney can and should pray for his intercession and canonization.

Remember that prayers to and for Father McGivney are really prayers asking God to act through and on behalf of the Blessed Servant of God.

REPORT. After asking Father McGivney to intercede for a particular intention, it is important to *report* any favors received – to let the Guild know if the prayer has been answered. You are encouraged to report any and every favor, big or small, so we can appreciate better the spiritual activity of the Blessed Servant of God. Medical and physical healings are especially important to report since they are most likely to be judged miraculous under strict Vatican guidelines.

JOIN. Step 3 is to join the Father McGivney Guild. Membership is free and you receive many benefits, including a quarterly newsletter with spiritual insights and updates on the cause, and a weekly Mass offered for the intentions of all Guild members. A Call to Holiness

Most importantly, the cause of Father McGivney is not simply about him being declared a saint. It is an opportunity for each one of us to seek his intercession and draw closer to God.

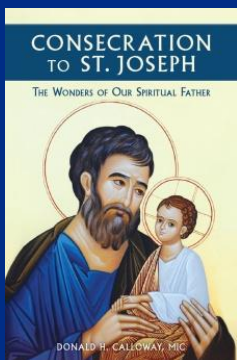

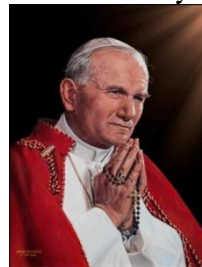
O Mary,

A Message from Grand Knight Ron Karaskiewicz

Protecting Our Most Precious Resource, Our children

Brothers,

In the world we live in today it is critically important that organizations such as the Knights of Columbus, the Archdioceses of Santa Fe, and The Church of the Incarnation establish and maintain child sexual abuse training as one step to help ensure a safe environment for our children. You all know the horror stories that have surfaced, and they are all simply dreadful. As Catholic men you must also recognize the need to strongly support these organizational efforts to combat this scar on the Church. Therefore, as Knights, we are obligated to be current with both Incarnation's training requirements, and Supremes' Safe Environment requirements.

I was given a list of Knights in Council 15199 that have either not taken the Incarnation training or have taken the training, but their certificate has expired. In either case, if you plan on volunteering at Church events, you are required to have a current certificate on file in the Church office. Without it, you will not be allowed to volunteer. Keep in mind that this training is separate from Supreme requirements under their Safe Environment program. Many of us need to take both classes, and although it may seem redundant, it is necessary.

The link to the training is on the Incarnation webpage. Look for it under the SERVE menu item on the top header followed by the VIRTUS link. There you can register, take the training, and generate the necessary certificate.

Brothers, this is critically important so please do your best to maintain a current Incarnation certificate.

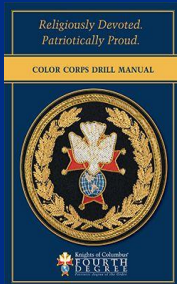
Park at the front of hospital parking and walk over to the parade field and Camp Murphy area for the shot.

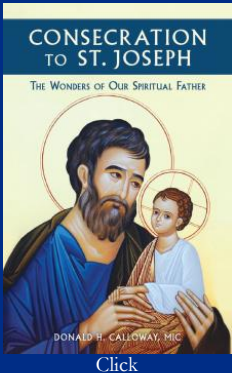

8 Ways the Knights Defend Life

Here are the various, unique ways Knights defend the dignity of each human being at every stage of life

The Knights of Columbus defends life in all its stages from conception to natural death. Blessed Michael McGivney founded the K of C to do just that, and since then, the Order has championed a number of [pro-life initiatives](#).

Here are some of the ways Knights defend life:

1. Caring for widows and orphans

The needs of suffering immigrant families inspired Father McGivney to [establish the Knights of Columbus](#) with an insurance program so that in the event of the loss of a breadwinner, families could stay together and avoid financial ruin. The [insurance program](#) continues to this day.

2. Standing against racial and religious discrimination

At the peak of the Ku Klux Klan's popularity, the Knights were among their most [staunch opponents](#). The Knights also [aided](#) Mexican Catholics persecuted by their government in the 1920s. Then, in 1938, the Order [advocated](#) for the protection of European Jews at the behest of the Jewish War Veterans.

3. Helping to plan every March for Life in Washington, D.C., since the first one in 1974

March for Life president Jeanne Mancini has [said](#) that, "Without Virginia Knights of Columbus, there would be no March for Life." Knights have also participated in local pro-life marches around the world, from Los Angeles to Ottawa to Mexico City to the Philippines.

4. Sponsoring a poll showing most Americans want restrictions on abortion

The Order has sponsored an annual poll gauging Americans' attitudes on abortion. The latest [poll](#), released January 2020, found that a large majority of Americans — and American voters — prefer to vote for candidates who support abortion restrictions. Most also want the Supreme Court to reinterpret *Roe v. Wade* to either allow states to decide on abortion restrictions themselves or to ban the procedure entirely.

5. Donating more than 1,000 ultrasound machines since 2009

These ultrasound machines help mothers to see their pre-born child. If every Knights-donated machine prompts four moms per week to keep their babies, over 1 million lives have been spared. Supreme Knight Carl Anderson has [stated](#) that the program is the “greatest humanitarian effort the organization has ever undertaken.”

6. Collaborating with the Special Olympics since its founding in 1968

K of C has a unique partnership with the Special Olympics and has helped disabled athletes train for and compete in games around the world. Knights have assisted with all aspects of the program from fundraising to feeding the athletes, organizing and judging events, and providing equipment and awards.

7. Defending persecuted Christians throughout the world

Knights advocate for the religious freedom of all peoples through the [Christian Refugee Relief](#) program, which helps at-risk Christians facing genocide all over the world, including in the Middle East and Nigeria. Since 2014, the Order has spent more than \$25 million to help those in the Middle East and has worked with the Obama and Trump administrations to direct international assistance to those areas targeted by ISIS.

8. Sponsoring prayer programs to support life

This past October, the Order sponsored a [Novena for the Cause of Life](#) and called all Catholics to join in prayer with Pope Francis for an end to abortion, euthanasia and the many social ills that bring illness, broken families, unhappiness and premature death, especially for the most vulnerable. The Order has also supported the [Silver Rose](#) program — a pro-life initiative the unites Canadian, U.S. and Mexican Knights — for the past 60 years.

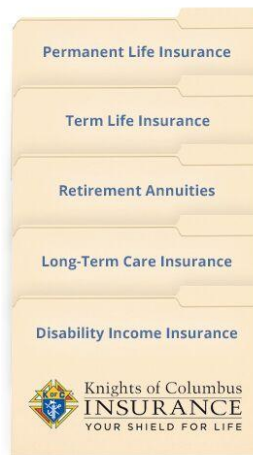

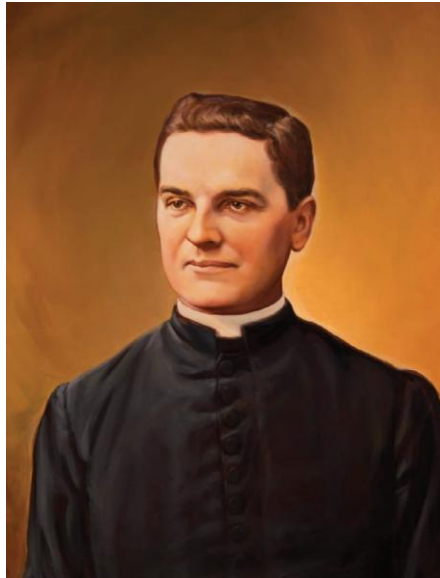

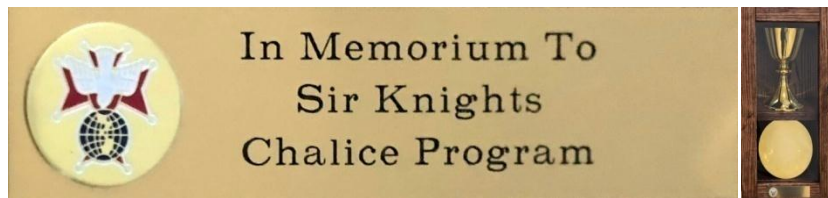
