SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

She said to him, “Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world.”

(Gospel for April 6, Jn 11:27)

These words belong to Martha, sister of Lazarus, as she and Jesus speak outside her brother’s tomb. Her choice of words is important: “I have come to believe.” This suggests her belief has evolved, that her previous uncertainty or ignorance about Jesus has blossomed into faith. Growing in faith is usually a process of moving from questioning or doubt to illumination and trust. How do we come to faith and then grow deeper in it? We do so through prayer, study and reflection. Let us continually deepen our faith in this manner.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to take part in a Catholic faith formation course, event or opportunity offered through your local council (such as *Cor*), your parish or diocese, or online.

Questions for Reflection:

Looking at the development of your own faith, how have you “come to believe” truths about Christ and/or the Catholic faith? What teachings do you still have questions about? What areas of your faith would you like to develop further? Where can you find resources — or whom can you ask for resources — to help you deepen your faith and understanding?

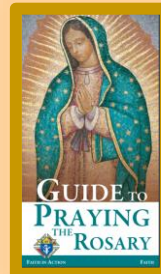

My Argument for the Church

Ezekiel 36:24-28

“I will take you away from among the nations, gather you from all the foreign lands, and bring you back to your own land. I will sprinkle clean water upon you and cleanse you from all your impurities, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. I will give you a new heart and place a new spirit within you, taking from your bodies your stony hearts and giving you natural hearts. I will put my spirit within you and make you live by my statutes, careful to observe my decrees. You shall live in the land I gave your fathers, you shall be my people, and I will be your God.”

Isaiah 9:6-7

“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government will be upon his shoulders, and his name will be called “Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David, and over his kingdom, to establish it, and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from this time forth and for evermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this”.

Is this canticle from Ezekiel speaking to the Israelites at the time? Of course. But is there a second answer, one that would be equally true? Is the symbolism of this passage from the Prophet Ezekiel telling us of a new order of things to come? When God speaks of bringing all peoples back to one place, of cleansing us with clean water, of replacing our stony hearts with natural hearts, living by Gods law; where is that place today?

The Roman Catholic Church.

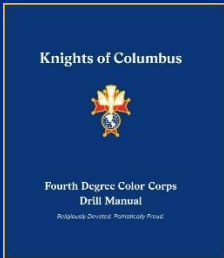
Isaiah, of course, is talking about Jesus Christ.

We know the Old Testament sets the foundation for the New Testament. The Torah sets the moral laws for the Hebrews that they will live by all the way into the New Testament, and beyond for many Jews.

We know that a great deal of our Church in the very beginning came from Jewish culture, Jesus and all the Apostles and disciples were, after all, Jews. From the Torah came the moral foundation of a way of life for the Jews that set the stage for the coming of the Church, the Church that Jesus began upon the Rock of Peter, the Church today that does all that God said He would do in Ezekiel. The Hebrews in the Old Testament needed their faith to get back to God, and He gave them their faith because He wanted them to come back to Him.

At the crucifixion, Jesus commits the care of his mother, Mary to his Apostle John, and John keeps that commitment. But Fr. Blake Britton, in his book “Reclaiming Vatican II”, explains the theology of Mary and John at the foot of the cross.

Jesus says to Mary, “Mother, behold your son”, and to John he says, “behold your mother”. Jesus has just established his mother, Mary, as *the* Church, not a person in the Church, but *the* Church; and John is now the people of the Church, the ones who need the Church to get back to God.

For Christians and Jews alike, in the Old and New Testaments, that symbiotic relationship between God and his people has existed for thousands of years, all the way back to Genesis when Adam and Eve lost the presence of God, and it still exists today.

In the introduction to his book “The Everlasting Man”, GK Chesterton comments, “When the world goes wrong, it proves the Church is right. The Church is justified, not because her people do not sin, but because they do”.

Regalia Wear – the KofC Fourth Degree standard is “One Button” used on the jacket. See the Drill Manual for photographic examples. The Bottom Button of the jacket is not used.

Could you wear the Fourth Degree uniform blazer with other slacks and a regular tie when going out? **The answer is: No**

Our uniform was designed to be worn complete with the Fourth Degree blazer, official slacks, tie, and official Fourth Degree pin (PG-113). It also requires a white dress shirt with no button-down collar, black shoes, and black socks. However, it may be worn in social settings such as Knights of Columbus events, banquets, exemplifications, meetings, and church.

The other components of the uniform are used when participating in our color corps (color guard or honor guard). Those include the official beret with flash representing office (if any), white gloves, a service baldric, a Fourth Degree sword with scabbard.

Flag bearers would not wear baldric or sword. (Note that the service baldric is either a general member baldric or else a specific color to indicate your current office held).

So, if you want to show your pride as a member of the Fourth Degree, then wear all the components according to the laws and rules of the Fourth Degree.

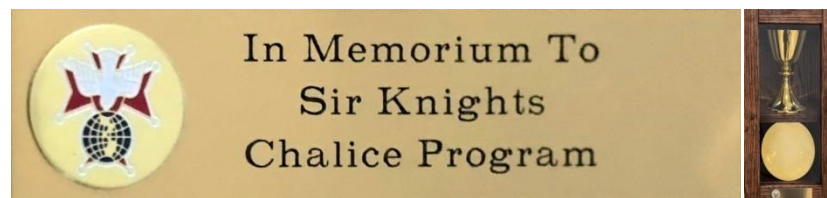

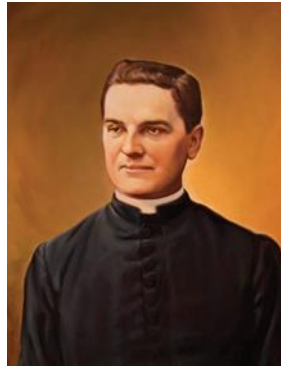
