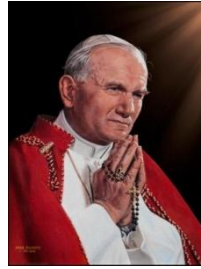

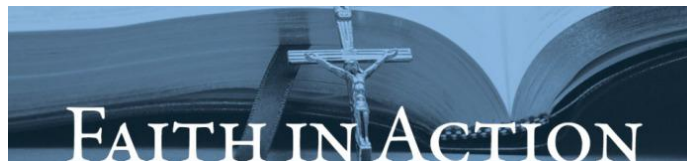

SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

April 2026

Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread. (Gospel for April 19, Lk 24:35)

The disciples on the road to Emmaus did not recognize Jesus until the breaking of the bread. Jesus promised he would be with us always, and the Eucharist is his fulfillment of that promise. We encounter his presence most profoundly in the Eucharist, where he is truly present — body, blood, soul, and divinity — under the appearance of bread and wine. The disciples' experience on the road to Emmaus was no ordinary meal, but an encounter with Christ, who invites us, too, to enter into communion with him through the Eucharist.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to remain in prayer and adoration for several minutes after Mass to grow in awareness of Christ's true presence in the Eucharist.

Questions for Reflection:

Do you fully realize it is the true body and blood of Christ that you receive in the Eucharist? Do you habitually pray in thanksgiving after Communion for this immeasurable gift? Do you consistently participate in Mass on Sundays and holy days? Do you make an effort to attend more frequently, so that you might avail yourself of the graces of this great sacrament?

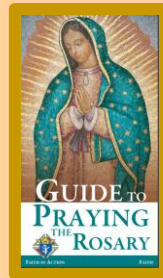

My Argument for Growing Old, Gods Way:

In his homily for All Souls Day, Fr. Michael talked about our societies obsession with cheating death, with anti-aging adds everywhere you turn, with the anti-aging industry's push to get us to get rid of our wrinkles, additives that promise to add years to our lives, and all the rest of the things they say we need to make us happy. But this was All Souls Day, and what he was getting at was that death was not the end, it is not something to fear. In some culture's it is considered just the beginning. We all know it's going to happen, and so on All Souls Day, we look at death as something to welcome, and that becomes countercultural in today's society.

But this also speaks to two other points:

First; we think that in some way we can push back God's clock, that we can put him off for just a little longer, and:

Second; that we can do it with *things*, or *stuff*, that man has made, and maybe, we think, it is that stuff that is somehow better than Gods *stuff*.

This asks a key question:

Are we looking at some of these things through the lens of getting healthier in order to better enjoy the years we have left, or are we looking at these things to extend our lives, to try to cheat death for just a little while longer, and maybe somehow fill an emptiness in us? In other words, is this a health question, or is it vanity? There is a difference, and it speaks directly to our faith, to our faith in God, and to our faith in God's plan for us.

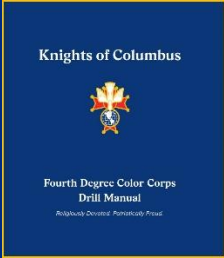
If we are looking at this as better overall health to improve the quality of the years we have, then that is a good thing; if, however, this is vanity, if we don't think we look good, or handsome, or beautiful in the eyes of others, then that is pride, it is arrogance, perhaps bordering on hubris's, that puts us in the middle of our own self-serving light. In the midst of all this, do we still even know God, does our presence in the middle of that light shadow God from us?

In her prayer journal, Flannery O'Conner writes:

"Dear God, I cannot love you he way I want to. You are the slim crescent of a moon that I see and my self is the earth's shadow that keeps me from seeing all the moon. The crescent is very beautiful and perhaps that is all one like I am should or could see; but what I am afraid of, dear God, is that my self-shadow will grow so large that it blocks the whole moon, and that I will judge myself by that shadow that is nothing.

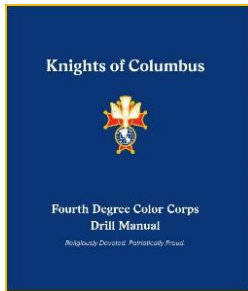
We are excited to announce the next V8's for Vocations raffle car is a 1962 Chevrolet Corvette!

Proper Present Sword

At a recent honor guard at my Parish, we had 14 Sir Knights that came early in the week for an Honor Guard.

How thankful we were for so many to show during the week. Our brothers that attended were mostly retired, and mainly over the age of 70.

We practiced our entrance, recession, and escorting the gifts for 30 minutes prior to the mass.

After mass the deacon serving was a Fourth-Degree brother Knight and member of our assembly. I asked, "how did we look?"

His response was one I was waiting for, "You guys looked great, but your swords were everywhere"

When dealing with an honor guard of men who varied in age from the late 50's to the early 80's, how does the honor guard stay consistent?

Practice is certainly a top choice but also keeping in mind the strength of your members and knowing if any member may have lost the ability to hold a sword at attention for a long period of time. This would require the CCC, Marshal, or whoever is leading the honor guard to be sensitive to when you go to present, where you place your weaker members in line, and how long you wait before you line up. Let's be sensitive to our aging members who have given a lot of time, effort, and energy to the Fourth Degree, we want them to participate as long as they can, but to also make sure that we are presenting ourselves in the best possible way. Any other suggestions you have would be appreciated and shared.

Just to refresh all of us, here is the proper present sword for all honor guards.

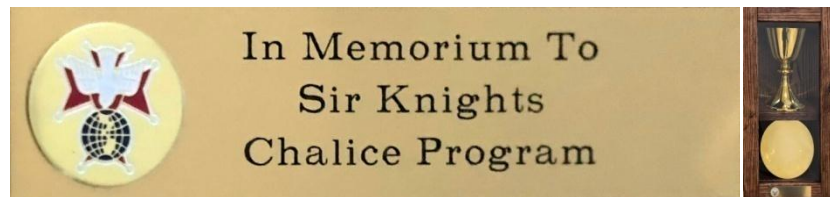

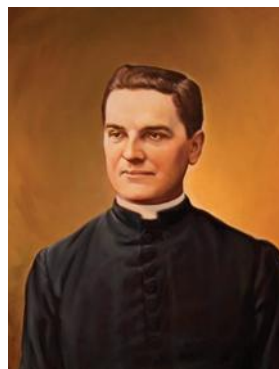
