"My God. My God, why have you forsaken me?"

Growing up in the Church when I was just a kid, I always thought this was a plea from Jesus to God to make it all stop, to take this all away from him, much like his prayer the night before in the garden of Getsemani. I thought he was, just for a moment, as I would be in His place, scared of dying.

But let me get back to that in a moment:

One of the things, one of the beautiful things I have learned on my journey back into the Church is the truly poetic beauty and importance of the Psalms. These are prayers to God, some written through the centuries from Moses on, and others thought to have been written by David, which were songs of praise, of desperation, of loss, of redemption, and of hope and trust in God and His love.

I started to appreciate the Psalms when I committed to praying the Liturgy of the Hours, the Catholic Church's tradition of praying several times a day, and is the second most important prayer of the Church, second only to the Liturgy of the Mass.

While the Psalms stand on their own, and always have through the centuries; and are part of the central prayers in Jewish prayer tradition, the Church understands that the Psalms are also the prayers Jesus prayed to his Father daily.

Now let me get back to where I started:

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me." Is Jesus giving up hope, or is he, as he did all through his life, praying to His Father. Clearly Jesus is praying a Psalm. "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me" is the first verse in Psalm 22. Now when you read the entire Psalm, you begin to get the sense of the significance of *that* Psalm, in *that* place, on *that* day, and in *that* moment.

Psalm 22 in all it's desperation, and at the same time, in all it's hope and trust in, and love of, God, written by David a thousand years before, speaks in some way to the entire ministry of Christ. The Navarre Bible comments that when Jesus spoke those words nailed to the cross, He was making the feelings of love and trust in God in that Psalm his own feelings as well.

But in a more direct way, the Psalm speaks more clearly to the crucifixion of Christ: Vs 16-18: "Yea, dogs are round bout me; they have pierced my hands and feet. I count all my bones – they stare and gloat over me; they divide my garments among them and for my raiment they cast lots."

This is the Psalm Jesus chose to pray in that place, on that day, and at that moment ... and now we know why.

Jesus, on that day and in that place, as He had throughout His entire ministry, was once again fulfilling the Scriptures that told of His coming as The Mesiah who would save the world.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:


This month — the month of Mary — I challenge you to pray the rosary daily with your entire household, offering at least one decade for the unity of your family and the Church.







Uniform Talk

The Color Corp of the Patriotic Degree

Worthies, the Supreme Master has encountered some Sir Knights inappropriately wearing name badges on the uniform. Please get the word out to your assemblies about proper wearing conditions.

As a reminder;

- 1. Any member may wear their assembly's Fourth Degree badge on the uniform.
- 2. It is worn on the right-hand side, level with the top of the left-hand pocket.
- 3. It is worn in social settings only. Never in an honor guard.
- 4. It should have a magnetic or pin backing since there is no pocket on the right breast.
- 5. There is no requirement for a specific style of badge nor a necessity to order a special badge from Knights Gear.
- 6. A member in Memphis asked the WSM if he could just add a magnetic backing to his current badge, and he said that would be fine.
- 7. The only exception to a Fourth Degree badge are badges of office for <u>current</u> state officers (including DDs) and a Past State Deputy.




