SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

"Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man." (Gospel for Dec. 1, Lk 21:36)





Deacon Mark's Homily, Part 2

Last month we talked about Deacon Mark's Sept 28th 4 PM homily and he hit on 3 major points:

- 1) The condition we're in currently (Last month's reflection)
- 2) How we got here (This month's reflection)
- 3) What are we going to do about it. (Next month's reflection).


Let's talk about how we got here. From where we're at today, and the final realization of just how bad it really is, it would be easy to think this is something new, at least within the last 100 to 150 years. In fact, the current version we're living in today, Marxist Socialism, is that new.

However, Marxist socialism is not the first time this has been tried. It's just a re-hash of the same old story told repeatedly all thru the ages. A story of greed, hubris, and the need to control entire societies, and not for the good of those societies, but rather for the good of those few who control those societies.

One of the things that every tyrant throughout history has understood was the absolute need to control the message, absolutely. Controlling the message, the same lies told repeatedly until they are perceived as truths, breeds loyalty among those who have been taught, thru the message, not to question the message, especially not to question those who sent the message, and to destroy anyone who does question the message or those who are sending the message.

Sound familiar? Today we know it as "cancel culture"."

That message, and those who send it, seek the ultimate destruction of the very moral fabric of a society. To destroy that moral fabric means to remove God and any belief in anything greater than ourselves, and replace it with the tyrant, who in our time, like so many times before, is the state. When God has been removed, or "canceled" as some have attempted to do today, that message tells the lie that good is evil and evil is good. "Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who change darkness to light and light to darkness, who change bitter into sweet and sweet into bitter." Isaiah 5:20


As Deacon Mark points out, today that message is *everywhere!* Turn on TV and every other commercial is for men's performance drugs that need no prescription. Go to any beach anywhere in the world and what do you see? More than you wanted to see - it's a safe bet the clothing industry is not doing very well there. Go to some restaurants and find on the table cards celebrating gay pride and encouraging you to donate to transgender charities, who tell you they are there to provide healthcare for those who live that lifestyle. There it is, right in front of you, as if to say "live with it, you can't do anything about it."

All of this didn't happen overnight. It didn't happen with one or two bad elections, or one or two pivotal events. This happened over a long period of time, in my opinion, since Marx himself. This happened slowly, gradually as the early message from the wolf in sheep's clothing was that we all are seeking the same thing, equality for all.

Like the frog who will not jump out of boiling water if it was cold at the start, we find ourselves now in boiling water. For far too many in our society today, that moral fabric is all but gone, and they are left to wander in the cold badlands of socialism. The last words of the Book of Judges ring true: "In those days there was no King in Israel; all the people did what was right in their own eyes."

For us, the "King of Israel" is our moral foundation born in the firm belief in God. However, throughout the ages there have been those who questioned. They were men and women of God, who lived the message of God to love your neighbor, not hate them. In the Old Testament they were scorned, or made to pay a heavy price. They were the lone voices crying out in the wilderness who eventually would bring Isreal back to God, time and again. In the New Testament we know many of them today as martyrs and saints. They are the voices calling out from Heaven above, calling us back to God, back to a love of each other, back to our straight and narrow path that will lead us to God.

Rest assured that the home office staff is busily preparing for the anniversary that will be celebrated on Saturday, February 22, 2025, at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City.

Your enthusiasm is evident! In the first few weeks of registration, Sir Knights have already purchased approximately 25% of the banquet tickets. If you wish to attend the degree on Saturday afternoon and stay for the banquet, please know that time is not on your side, as ticket sales are going quite well. Click **HERE** to purchase tickets.

We have also secured a group rate at several hotels and information and reservation links can be found **here**. Just click on the hotel name to access each reservation page. Please note that once these blocks are filled, we will not be able to secure any additional contracts, so it's important to act quickly. If these options do not work for you or if they sell out, we recommend checking Expedia and searching for hotels near St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City.

On December 3rd, my staff and I will be meeting with staff from both St. Patrick's and the New York Hilton, Midtown Manhattan. Soon after, I will be able to share more details with you regarding the anniversary celebration. However, the most important thing to share now is that this will be the premiere of the Revised Patriotic Degree. Supreme Assembly Launching Special Program

125 for 125 Special Challenge for the 125th <u>UPDATE</u>

After further prayer and reflection, I am adopting the recommendation of a Regional Growth Director as a revision to the *125 for 125 Membership Challenge*. Specifically, District Masters are challenged to conduct one Anniversary Exemplification in honor of the 125th Anniversary of the Fourth Degree from February 23, 2025-August 31, 2025, as follows:

If their District quota is 125 or higher, their objective is to conduct an exemplification with 125 candidates in that one class.

If their District quota is below 125, their objective is to conduct an exemplification where the district achieves or exceeds 125% of their quota for Fraternal Year 2024-2025.

So, the bottom line is whichever is less (125 candidates or 125% of your quota) qualifies. However, where achieving 125% of your quota would actually put you over 125 candidates, you are not required to have a class larger than 125.

Korean & Vietnam War Census Program

The Fourth Degree will conduct a census of the membership to establish a record of service in the Korean and Vietnam Wars.

Following the World Wars, the Order documented war service by its members in the archives at the Blessed Michael J. McGivney Pilgrimage Center however similar efforts were not conducted following either the Korean or Vietnam Wars.

The Korean War commenced in 1950, making the approximate minimum age of surviving veterans ninety-one years old. The approximate minimum age of surviving Vietnam veterans serving from 1965-1973 is 68-76 years old. Both the Korean and Vietnam Wars marked a significant departure in how troops served and returned from war, as service was no longer for the duration. Gone were the hero's welcome on return. Vietnam veterans returned to a hostile and divided nation, where they were either overlooked or criticized for their service.


For Assemblies working in conjunction with their assigned councils in conducting the census of their membership please use the most current form;

Where possible, documented service of deceased members needs to be recorded. Inclusion in the census shall be limited to veterans meeting the requirements established by Congress for the Korean Service Medal you must have served from June 25, 1950, to July 27, 1953, and was on permanent assignment or on temporary duty for 30 consecutive days or 60 non-consecutive days and performed his duty within the country of Korea. For the Vietnam Service Medals, you must of served from July 3 1965 to March 28 1973 and was on temporary duty for at least 30 consecutive days or 60 nonconsecutive days or have served in combat with a unit directly supporting a military operation in Southeast Asia (Vietnam and the contiguous waters and airspace in Thailand, Laos, or Cambodia; or the airspace thereof and in the direct support of military operations in Vietnam.

Certificates recognizing service will be delivered to surviving veterans via their councils. District Masters, it is recommended that you reach out to all your Faithful Navigators to collaborate with their local Grand Knights to hold a party or dinner for those Veterans receiving the certificate. There should also be a 4th Degree Honor Guard present during the certificate presentation. Let us show our appreciation to those veterans in our council who served in these two wars and to let them know that their sacrifices are not forgotten.

Wearing the Uniform

Regalia Wear – the KofC Fourth Degree standard is "One Button" used on the jacket. See the Drill Manual for photographic examples. The Bottom Button of the jacket is not used.

Could you wear the Fourth Degree uniform blazer with other slacks and a regular tie when going out? The answer is: No

Our uniform was designed to be worn complete with the Fourth Degree blazer, official slacks, tie, and official Fourth Degree pin (PG-113). It also requires a white dress shirt with no button-down collar, black shoes, and black socks. However, it may be worn in social settings such as Knights of Columbus events, banquets, exemplifications, meetings, and church.

The other components of the uniform are used when participating in our color corps (color guard or honor guard). Those include the official beret with flash representing office (if any), white gloves, a service baldric, a Fourth Degree sword with scabbard. Flag bearers would not wear baldric or sword. (Note that the service baldric is either a general member baldric or else a specific color to indicate your current office held).

So, if you want to show your pride as a member of the Fourth Degree, then wear all the components according to the laws and rules of the Fourth Degree.
