SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

February 2026

“Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you [falsely] because of me.” (Gospel for Feb. 1, Mt 5:11)

In the next verse, Jesus continues, “Thus they persecuted the prophets who were before you” (Mt 5:12b). His words imply that his disciples are prophets in their own right, following after the prophets of old. Indeed, as his disciples, we become priests, prophets and kings by virtue of our baptism. In our prophetic role, we are called to speak God’s truth even when it is unpopular in the eyes of the world.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to learn more about the Church’s teachings on one or two contemporary issues that you are concerned about, so that you can better defend the truth when an opportunity arises. Look to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and booklets from the Order’s Catholic Information Service (kofc.org/cis) as resources.

Questions for Reflection:

Do you shy away from speaking the truth because you fear opposition or repercussions? Does your silence on issues of faith or morals sometimes give others the false impression of agreement? How do you make sure you are being respectful and charitable to others when speaking the truth?

How To Renew the Faith in Your Council

How engaged is your Knights of Columbus council in the faith lives of the men of your parish? As we prepare for the Lenten season, and to welcome newly catechized members of the Body of Christ through OCIA, it is the perfect time to launch a faith formation component in your local Knights of Columbus council. As you no doubt are aware, there are a great number of videos, [Catholic Information Service](#) booklets, Bible studies, and *Cor* materials that have been produced by the Knights of Columbus and can be seamlessly woven into the normal program activity of your council.

A simple way to begin is to work with your grand knight or his designee to organize a viewing of one of the videos on the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council [YouTube](#) page, and then lead a short discussion about the video, concluding with some intercessory prayer around the topic. Many of the videos would also make a compelling showing in a parish hall during a Lenten fish fry, parish day of reflection, or men's retreat. The K of C-produced Bible study [Men of the Word](#) — or new *Cor* materials on the life of Blessed Michael McGivney or a topic of your choice — would also make an excellent way to start or enhance a *Cor* session for all the men of your parish.

Each state council has a designated state *Cor* facilitator who could also be invaluable should you desire further assistance to get *Cor* training for your local council leaders or to talk through ideas you may have, given the dynamics of your parish. All of this will likely require your pastoral participation to at least encourage a new foothold of the faith in your council. It is also likely that the men of your council want to go deeper, but may just need your assistance. It's 2026: Let's ensure that every man who comes to a Knights event leaves with a deeper knowledge of his faith, an encounter with the Body of Christ, and an opportunity to pray with another.



My Argument for the voices in our heads:

“Before I can live with other folks, I've got to live with myself.”
— Harper Lee, *To Kill a Mockingbird*

We have all, at one time or another, done or said something that we immediately came to regret. That immediate regret is a moment of conscience.

It may well have tried to visit us when we were saying things we later regret, or doing things that we were not very proud of. At those moments when our conscience is waving its arms, when the voice in our head is yelling at us, we simply choose to ignore it.

But at the end of the day, when we stand in front of the mirror getting ready for bed, it comes back to us, and we know, without a doubt, because we chose to ignore that voice, we hurt someone that day, and now we hurt.

Bishop Barron contends that from the very start we are wired for God. If he is right, and I think he is, then that means that from our birth we have a very basic instinctual understanding of right and wrong. You could say it is part of our instinct for survival.

As we grow that instinct becomes conscience and is formed, for better or worse, by the environment we live in. But even if we are raised in a bad condition, we still, in our very soul, understand when we have done wrong. What we do or don't do about it is a result of that environment, but we still know.

Our conscience helps us understand that we still have to accept responsibility for what we did...and if necessary, make amends for it, and that becomes more difficult to do. Not because our ego tells us we did no wrong, but because we know we did, and somehow, we fear our words and actions of apology and atonement are just not enough. But if our conscience is well formed, we know it must be done.

Living with ourselves is an art form, a dance, a balancing act, a challenge, and sometimes just a plain nuisance ... it is easier however, if we learn to listen to the voice of our conscience.

I sometimes hear people say God doesn't talk to them. I disagree, if your conscience bothers you, or worse, hurts when you've done wrong, then God is there. If Barron is right, if we are wired for God, then God lives in us, he is our conscience;


and the voice of our conscience, that voice in our head, is the voice of God talking to us.

When it comes to supporting vulnerable mothers and their children, both born and unborn, the Knights of Columbus will never waver! And the more we grow the Order, the more life-saving support we can provide! That's why we're launching the **Join ASAP Incentive!**

Councils that recruit 3 members between **February 1 and March 31** AND donate at least \$500 through the ASAP program any time during the 2025-26 fraternal year (including donations made since July 1, 2025) will receive an additional \$250 for the pregnancy resource center or maternity home they supported.

The top 10 recruiting councils will also receive an additional \$750 for the pregnancy resource or maternity home, bringing the total incentive to \$1,000 for those winners!




