All the Noise in the World, Revisited.

When I went back to work at Christus St. Vincent in November of 2010 I was on a 6 month probation, which was normal. My office was in the phone room downstairs with the other guy in Systems and Telecom. It was a noisy room with all the fans running on banks of gateways that provide service to over 5000 extensions as well as the data switches and routers for other services in the area. The decibel level in that room sometimes bordered on unsafe. But when you work in there for a while you quit hearing all that, the noise doesn't go away, you just quit hearing it.

For 6 months everyone in Systems and Telecom and IS in general, *including my boss*, had repeatedly told me there was no way to make the entire phone system fail, there was so much redundancy built into it.

3 days after my probation I was microwaving chicken for breakfast in the phone room using a microwave our boss had provided, and you guessed it, I brought down the entire phone system, all the fans on everything in that room had gone *completely* silent. If I told you the silence in that room was deafening, it would be a gross understatement!!!

I told you that so I could talk about this:

I think it's safe to say we are all tired of the mean and vindictive nature of where our society is right now. At some level, just the fact that we're in that society means our first tendency when we want to push back is to be mean and vindictive too. That's a part that has been ingrained in us for years and justifies this as a "fight fire with fire" response. We actually think, or think we know, that's the only way we'll be heard, and with everybody doing it the noise levels just keep going up.

In all my years in Law Enforcement that was how we got things done, we fought fire with fire, and it was an easy lesson to learn, because that's also how we were raised.

But as I grew older my heart kept telling me there was a better way, how to turn down the anger and the noise. Jesus did it, St. Paul did it. I've always known how Jesus did it, he is the Son of God, and smart people knew it. But St. Paul I didn't get. How did St. Paul do so much good without any "fight fire with fire", how was he so effective and still kept the noise level down? That question was at the top of my list of so many questions with no easy answer, or no answer at all; and so started my journey back into the Church.

I was completely fascinated with St. Paul, a man who had left the violence of persecuting Christians to begin the peaceful furtherance of Christians. I know what the New Testament tells us about the story of his conversion. But I wanted to know more. I wanted to know what that felt like, deep in his heart and soul.

I knew I wanted to feel that too. For years I have had that feeling that there was something missing, and with that question I finally knew what it was. It was Jesus in his heart and soul. As my journey continues I get closer to that feeling, and I want more. But it also starts to answer other questions about how Paul was so effective with so much peace in his heart. There was a lot of prayer.

Prayer is the root of our path to God thru the Church. It is something I often struggle with, praying the Liturgy of the Hours can sometimes feel like it's getting old, and I need to set my mind in order by remembering these are the prayers of the Church to Jesus.

Pam and I were talking with Dcn George a few months back about something and during the course of that conversation he made a comment about the priests who had gotten in trouble with sexual mis-conduct over the years. He said that when they were asked when their trouble began, almost to a man they said it began when they stopped praying.

My struggle to pray is in the distraction of all that noise day in and day out, it's hard to concentrate, to say on track. But when I get through it, I'm at better peace in my heart.

Jesus tells us in Mathew: "When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to stand and pray in the synagogues and street corners so that others may see them. Amen, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you".

"Go to your inner room and close the door". Jesus gives us a place free from all the noise of the world around us today.

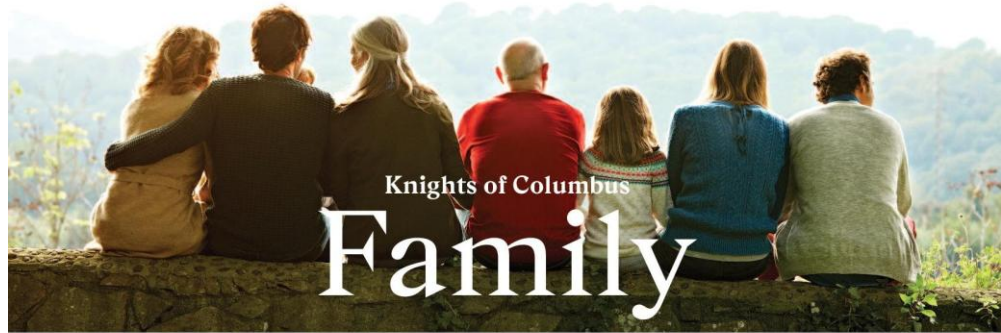
I have found a place like that now, and I'm here to tell you, *it works*.

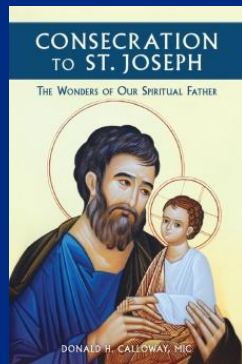

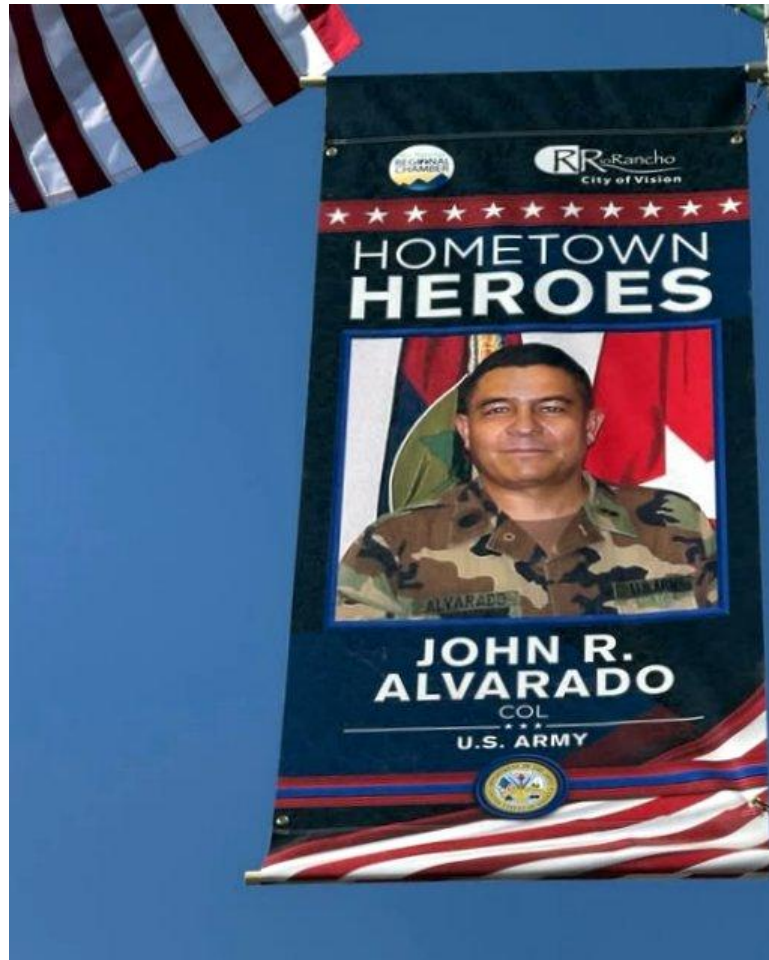

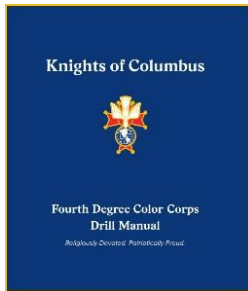

Proper Present Sword

At a recent honor guard at my Parish, we had 14 Sir Knights that came early in the week for an Honor Guard.

How thankful we were for so many to show during the week. Our brothers that attended were mostly retired, and mainly over the age of 70.

We practiced our entrance, recession, and escorting the gifts for 30 minutes prior to the mass.

After mass the deacon serving was a Fourth-Degree brother Knight and member of our assembly. I asked, "how did we look?"

His response was one I was waiting for, "You guys looked great, but your swords were everywhere"

When dealing with an honor guard of men who varied in age from the late 50's to the early 80's, how does the honor guard stay consistent?

Practice is certainly a top choice but also keeping in mind the strength of your members and knowing if any member may have lost the ability to hold a sword at attention for a long period of time. This would require the CCC, Marshal, or whoever is leading the honor guard to be sensitive to when you go to present, where you place your weaker members in line, and how long you wait before you line up. Let's be sensitive to our aging members who have given a lot of time, effort, and energy to the Fourth Degree, we want them to participate as long as they can, but to also make sure that we are presenting ourselves in the best possible way. Any other suggestions you have would be appreciated and shared.

Just to refresh all of us, here is the proper present sword for all honor guards.

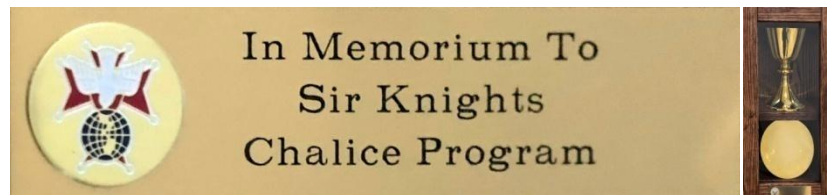

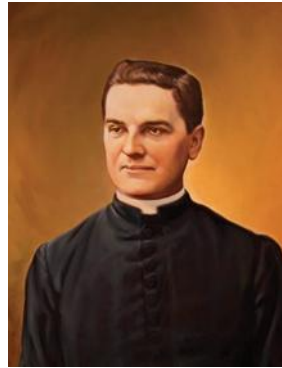
