



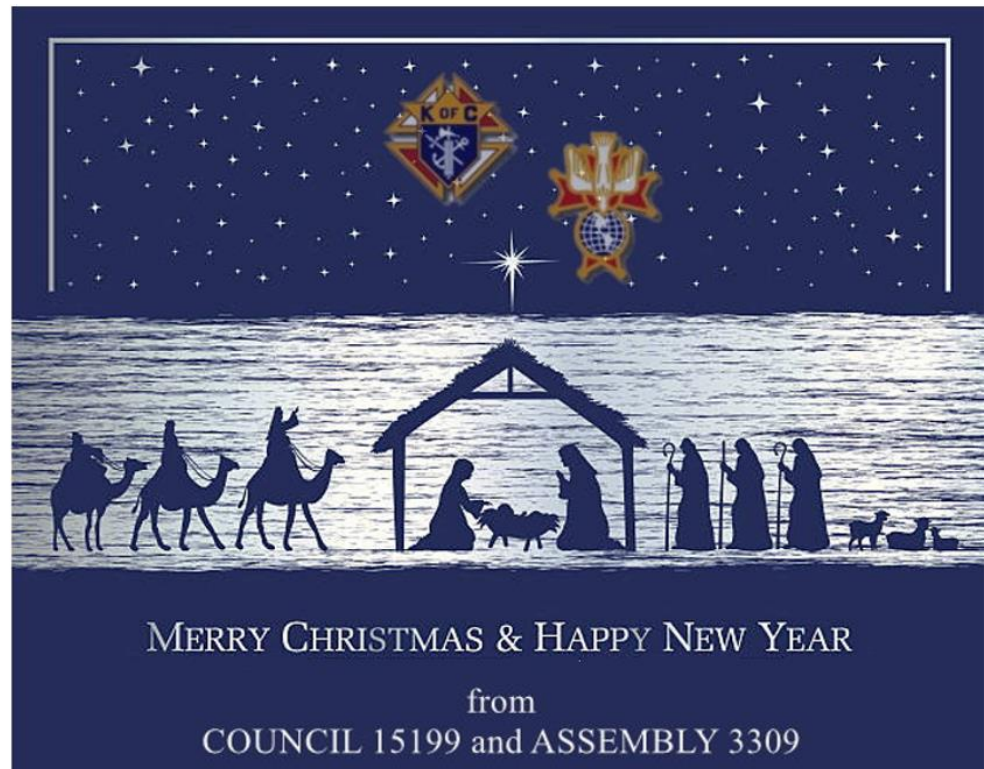

DECEMBER 2025 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

“Even now the ax lies at the root of the trees. Therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.” (Gospel for Dec. 7, Mt 3:10)

In these reflections over the past year, we have meditated on the importance of our faith bearing fruit in good works. In a way, this Gospel passage, quoting St. John the Baptist, might seem out of place during Advent. But throughout this season, we reflect not only on Christ’s coming in the incarnation, but also his second coming in judgment at the end of the world. Let us pray and work to ensure we lead truly faithful and fruitful lives as disciples of Jesus.

This month, I challenge you to spend some time reflecting on the four last things — death, judgment, heaven and hell — to better prepare yourself for eternity.

Questions for Reflection:

Do I live with my sights set on heaven? Am I aware of the reality of hell? Do I live my life so as to be prepared for my death and judgment?

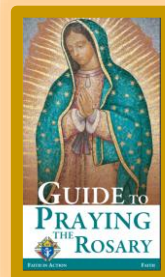

And That Is Enough for Now:

I was reading an article from Work on Fire Evangelization & Culture recently written by Dr. Tod Worner. He was describing what he had seen the day the last of the hostages were released by Hamas back to their Israeli families. We all saw some of it on national TV, and when we watched, we were happy for their return, and for the families they returned to. While the tensions in the Middle East are not over, and some of the fighting in Gaza is still going on, Dr. Worner was making the point that these hostages returning home was, in and of itself, a *very* important moment, for the world, for us who watched, for Israel, and most importantly for those families.

In a world that is so cynical, so angry, that questions every win we can get, that questions why the other problems weren't solved first, we have to take a step back and appreciate what we got in that moment. What we got, was one step closer, maybe a small step albeit, but a step just the same, closer to peace. A step that would not have happened were it not for all those who worked to negotiate that moment.

"Blessed be the peacemakers, for they shall be called the children of God."

A very wise old Sergeant, one of the wisest men I ever had the honor of knowing, worked a domestic call with me one night on graveyard. When we came out of the call and were getting back into our cars I made the comment, "I don't know that we did any good." He answered, "we did do some good, we stopped the fighting, maybe just for a little while, but we did stop the fighting, did ya see the looks on those children's faces when the fighting stopped?"

Then he said, "Whitey, take your wins where you can get them." And ya know, we didn't have to go back to that house again that night.

Some years later I was working days during the summer. We got a call for a lost child, a 4 year old boy who was last seen, by his mother, chasing after some stray cat. Me and a couple of other officers started searching the neighborhood and I soon found him in a bush a couple of houses down, still chasing after that ~~damn~~, uh - darn cat.

The look on that mother's face when I brought the boy back, along with that mangy cat, was of joy, relief, and love for her son, and it somehow humbled me. For me, it was just another call on another day, but for that mother who was living in that moment, it was the most important moment in her entire life.

Dr. Worner went on to talk about the parable of the lost sheep, the parable of the prodigal son, the joy of those who have just found their lost ones. He talked about that look of joy, relief, and love he saw on the faces of the families who were living in that moment, it was the most important moments of their entire lives.

When I was reading this article from Dr. Worner, I was reminded of that night with Sgt. Angel Torres, a deeply religious Catholic man, and what he was trying to tell me.

Worner ends his article with this:

"Because in those moments of reunion, I saw God. And that is enough for now."

Looking back, I know now I saw God in those children's faces, I saw Him in that mother's face; and I think that's what that wise old Sgt. was trying to telling me that night:

Take your wins where you can get them, find God in them, because He's *always* there, and then:

Well - Maybe that's enough for now.

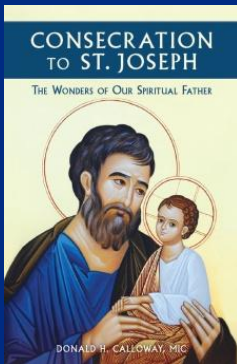
